ABOUT XPERT COMPETITION

Xpert is an exciting international competition for students in grades 5 to 12, starting with Mathematics and designed to reward academic excellence. The competition helps students strengthen their math skills while giving them a chance to compete at a global level. We invite students from primary, secondary, and high schools to take part in our math challenges and test their knowledge against students from around the world. The top students will earn a spot at the Xpert Elite Final, hosted in the United States of America, where they'll compete and have the chance to enjoy fun social activities and excursions.

HOW XPERT WORKS?

The Xpert Competition consists of two phases: the Qualification Phase and the Xpert Elite Finals.

The **Qualification Phase** is an online qualification round where students compete for the chance to secure their spot in the **Xpert Elite Finals** which will be held in the USA and UK.

XPERT QUALIFICATION PHASE

Ignition Round

- First step of the Online Qualification Phase.
- 30 multiple-choice questions from the first chapter of the syllabus.
- 60-minute time limit.
- Earn up to 15 points for correct answers.

Acceleration Round

- Second step of the Online Qualification Phase.
- 30 multiple-choice questions from the second chapter of the syllabus.
- 60-minute time limit.
- Earn up to 15 points for correct answers.
- Students can take this round even if they missed the first round.

Final Orbit Round

- Last step of the Online Qualification Phase.
- 30 multiple-choice questions from the final chapter of the syllabus.
- 60-minute time limit.
- Earn up to 70 points for correct answers.
- Students can still participate even if they missed the first two rounds.
